Nada Spencer is a self-taught ceramic artist from Cape Town and is known for her various mono-printing and surface decoration techniques. She views clay as her mouldable canvas and her affection for its inherent versatility has been a constant source of inspiration. Her artistic style encompasses an array of expressions, from large textured pots, with layers of painted slip and etched drawings to smooth glazed platters and botanical tiles. She enjoys experimenting with a variety of techniques, clays and glazes. She has a passion for teaching and has been running a teaching studio for over 8 years. She has presented numerous workshops, including an international workshop through The Ceramic School. She was Chairperson of the Western Cape Ceramics Southern Africa society from 2019 to 2021 and was on the committee for 4 years.

In this is workshop we will cover several surface decorating techniques, like: water etching & monoprints on clay

What to bring with:

- 2x small bone dry vessels (small cylinder shape/cup/bowl) made with preferably a smooth clay body. ie: Slipcast with Reinders SW, or Porcelain Cone 5, or Walford White or anything similar.
- A small slab of smooth terracotta or black clay for monoprinting.
- Soft glaze/paint brushes, underglazes, decorating slips, small brushes, scissors, pencils, rubber kidney ribs, sponges, plastic container for water to be used during water etching
- Notebook & pencil
